What will the workshop provide?

The three hour workshop will provide practical skills and strategies to help parents and caregivers understand, decrease and respond to behavioural difficulties.

The interactive video format allows participants to learn behaviour management strategies, practice the techniques in the companion workbook and critique the exercises.

What will I learn?

Topics will include:

- Communication
- Setting Expectations
- Praising
- Correcting Behaviour
- Reflective Listening
- Recognizing and Responding to Challenging Behaviour

A participant workbook will be provided (\$2 per booklet is suggested to cover the cost)

Who should attend?

The workshop is designed for parents and others who support children with neurological disorders (ADHD, Tourette Syndrome, Obsessive Compulsive Disorder, Anxiety, Mood Disorders, Learning Disabilities, Autism etc). It is however, **an excellent learning resource for caregivers of ALL children.**
